## Year 1 Trip to Barleylands on Tuesday 26th September

If you would like your child to receive a free school packed lunch, please select the option on the school gateway app and request in the notes one of the choices - cheese, ham, tuna sandwich or N/A. We will need to know no later than Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September if you require one. If you do not order one we will assume that you are sending a lunch into school with them. We are unable to make lunches up on the morning of a trip.

A donation of £18.00 towards the cost of the trip would be appreciated. Also, after the trip and payment received each child will receive a one free day Barleyland pass to visit the park at your leisure.

Payment and consent must be made by **Tuesday 19**th **September.** I have added the payment onto the school gateway app as a reducing balance so you are able to pay smaller amounts weekly, fortnightly or even monthly to help ease the cost of this visit. If you require pay point voucher please request one at the office. Payments are non-refundable and non-transferable unless we have to cancel the trip for reasons beyond our control.
