Year 5 Egyptian workshop
on Thursday 25th April 2024.

As part of the Year 5 curriculum for Summer 1, we have organised for an Ancient Egyptian architecture workshop to be held in school. During the workshop the pupils will get to build individual square-based pyramids, which they fix together to make a larger one, learning about square numbers as they do so. There is a dramatic element to the workshop, as pupils demonstrate the use of rollers to move a heavy stone. The finale is building the great pyramid of Giza, about 5m high, in which all the pupils are asked to become mummies.

This workshop is very engaging and interactive and will involve a lot of teamwork and cooperation.
