Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 trip to Chafford Gorge Nature Park

We have arranged for our year 3 classes to visit Chafford Gorge Nature Park on Thursday 13th June 2024. As part of the school's curriculum in the Summer 2 term we have organised a fun packed day which compliments and develops the learning experiences your child is currently offered in class.

They will be taking part in the following workshop:

Plant Power

Discover the wonderful world of flowers and trees and why they are important to our lives. Follow the plants through their lifecycle with a range of fun activities. What makes up a plant? How are different seeds dispersed? We will even learn to identify a range of plants. You may even meet the insects that need them to survive.

The cost of this educational visit is £11.58 per child. Based on the number of children in year 3, the breakdown of this visits is as follows:

£7.00 per child for a full day's programme of activities £4.58 per child for transport to and from destination.

The children will need to wear non-school uniform, a sun hat, old clothing, and sturdy footwear or wellies - suitable for walking on rough ground. Please make sure that your child has sun cream applied before school.

The children will be transported by our usual company with seat belts, leaving school promptly at 9.20am. They will return to school at approximately 2.45pm. Please collect your child at the normal time at the end of the school day.

If your child is eligible to receive a free school packed lunch, please write your choice in the comments section on the school gateway app Cheese, Ham or Tune or N/A if you do not need one. If you do not indicate that you would like the school to supply a packed lunch for your child we will assume that you are sending a lunch into school with them. We are unable to make any up on the day. We will need to know no later than Monday 10th June 2024 if you require the school to provide your child with a packed lunch.

A donation of £11.58 would be appreciated to cover the cost of your child attending this visit. These visits are a valuable and enjoyable opportunity that enhances the curriculum. Without your continued support with the cost we would be unable to provide them. Please use the school gateway app to make this donation. Payments for all trips are non-refundable and non-transferable.
